# ATTENTION

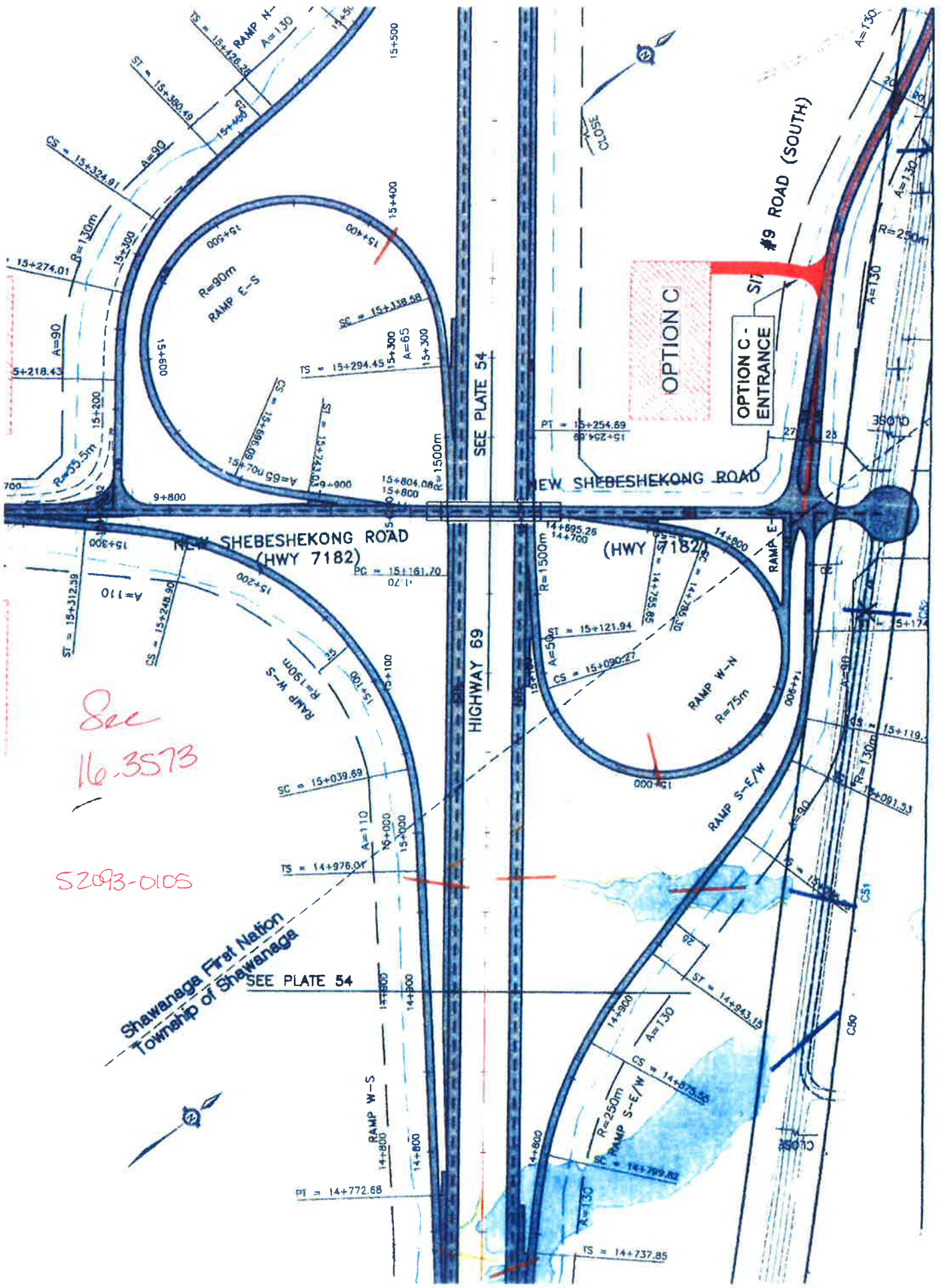


The Shawanaga Administration would like to advise the community and its members that *Weeks Construction* will begin clearing a site on our land starting as soon as possible. We are moving forward with our future Highway Service Centre project and we need to clear a site for the construction to begin. We have chosen *Weeks Construction* to take the lead on this clearing project as our timeframe is delicate. The area that will be cleared can be found across from:

## **Bah-sah-gim Road**

Approximately 8-10 acres of land will be cleared. Included in the clearing will be: mobilization of equipment and personnel to site, clearing of trees and piling of logs onsite, burning of brush onsite, excavation and burying/piling of stumps onsite (or nearby), and demobilization of equipment and personnel from site. All materials and matter found will be left onsite to be utilized by the community.

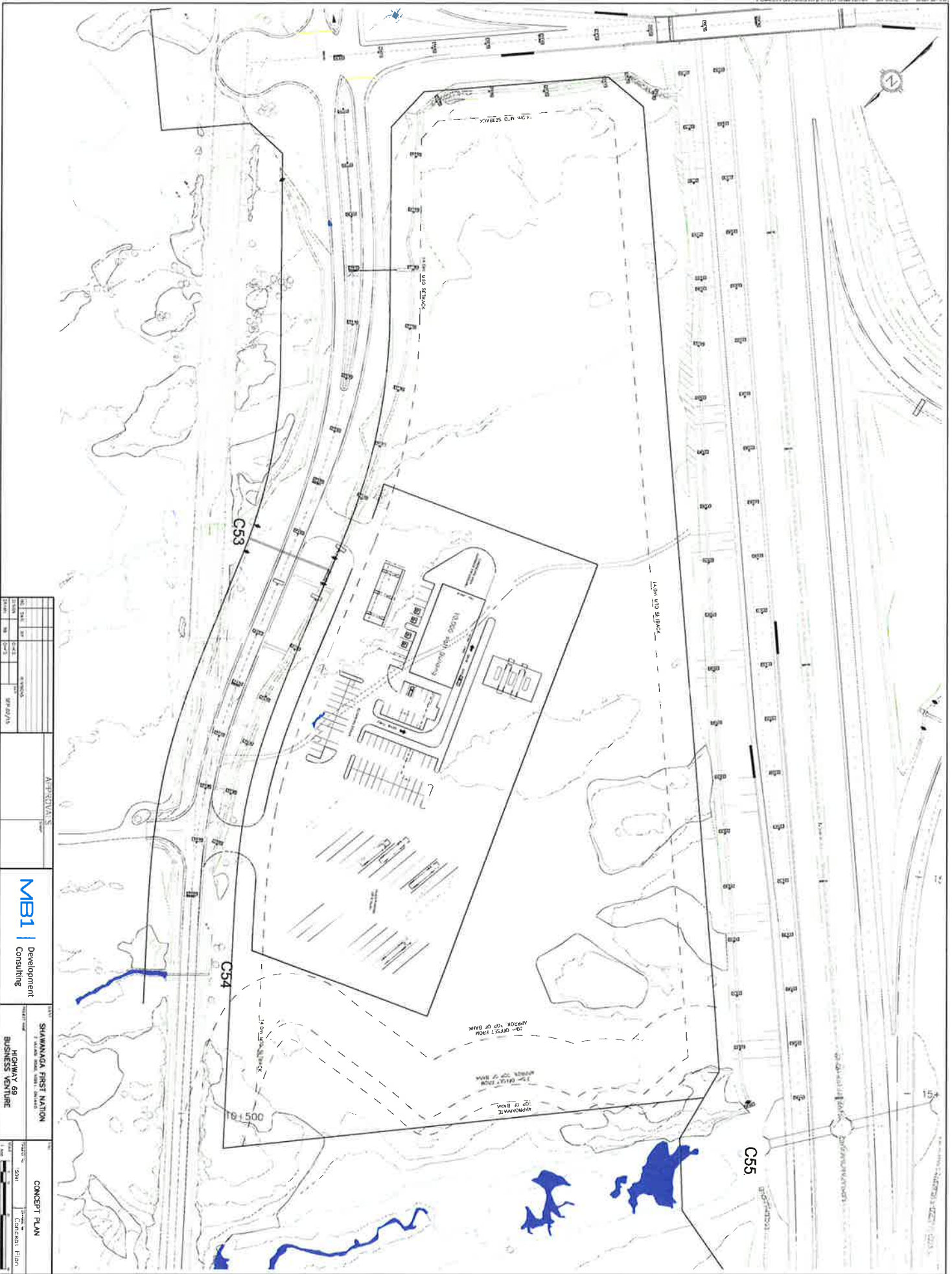
