

## PROJECT BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES



Shawanaga First Nation ("SFN") is looking to review, enhance, and implement a custom election code to govern the election process for the First Nation and address any issues currently expressed by the membership.





The primary objectives of the project are to:

- Understand the issues with the current draft of the SFN Custom Election Code;
- Review the current draft of the SFN Custom Election Code with comparable custom codes from other First Nations and organizations across Canada;
- Identify any gaps or issues with the current draft of the SFN Custom Election Code;
- Recommend enhancements to the current draft of the SFN Custom Election Code; and
- Review, confirm, and implement an updated SFN Custom Election Code.

The completed work will result in a finalized SFN Custom Election Code which will be presented and ratified through community engagement.
